

WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES

The board authorizes the issuance of cellular phones wireless communication devices to staff designated by the superintendent. The primary purpose of these district-owned wireless communication devices will be for official district business and use. Reasonable usage of district-owned wireless communication devices is acceptable, to the extent it does not interfere with official business. Personal use guidelines will be the same as district-owned land based telephones.

An employee's use of wireless communication may be restricted, at management's sole discretion, to only official business use if voice or data usage reaches excessive levels or significantly increases costs to the district. All policies applicable to district computer usage shall apply to wireless data connectivity.
