  - Targeted language acquisition supports for invited students
- HS Credit Retrieval/Advancement
  - Individual online learning modules with certificated staff support on-site
- Life Skills Summer Program
  - One on one support for the month of July.

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# 2021-2022 RECOVERY



- Core Curriculum
  - Rigorous coursework provided to all students
- Seminars
  - Local community presentations to elementary students
- Project-Based Learning
  - Students learning by actively engaging in real-world and personally meaningful projects.
- Differentiated Instruction
  - Tailored classroom instruction to meet individual needs

# 2021-2022 RECOVERY



- GLAD/SIOP strategies
  - Instruction using an integrated, balanced literacy approach
- Internships, community service
  - Students engaging with and meeting the needs of the local community
- Mentors, Morning Meetings
  - Building relationships with each and every student through organized content and practices
- Hope Squad
  - Suicide awareness training, curriculum and programming for secondary students



# 2021-2022 RECOVERY



- Kelso's Choice
  - All students included in core coursework
- Manson Inc. & Family Leadership Institute
  - Family based training focused on support of students
- TBIP (transitional bilingual) early exit
  - Students begin their education in native language and slowly add English to subject areas through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
- Credit Retrieval
  - Targeted coursework for students not on track to graduate in their identified year
